

BELLIS MUSIC CAMP

August 16 – 22, 2009

- 1. How to get to camp:** Bellis Music Camp is held at the Angeles Crest Christian Camp in the Angeles National Forest. It is located approximately 35 miles above the city of La Canada, just off Highway 2 on Sulfur Springs Road. From any direction, take the Angeles Crest Highway (Highway 2) exit off of the 210 freeway. Proceed north on the Angeles Crest Highway into the mountains. Angeles Crest Christian Camp is located approximately 35 miles into the mountains and takes approximately 45 minutes to drive to, from the bottom of the hill. As you head north on Angeles Crest Highway, go past the Mt. Wilson Turnoff (approximately 15 miles) and past the Chilao Campgrounds (approximately 25 miles). Stay on Highway 2 until you pass Newcomb's Ranch Restaurant (on your left hand side). Approximately one and a half miles past Newcomb's, turn left on Sulfur Springs Road (look for a sign that says "Organized Camps"). Follow the road and look for the entrance sign to Angeles Crest Christian Camp. (Special note: There aren't any gas stations after you leave the bottom of the hill in La Canada. There is no cell phone service once you head into the mountains.)
- 2. Starting Time:** Camp begins with registration at 4:30 p.m., Sunday, August 16, 2009. **Please do not arrive early.**
- 3. Concert Time:** 2:00 p.m., Saturday, August 22, 2009. Please plan on attending an outdoor concert held at the camp Amphitheater and then take your camper home afterward. All performers are expected to remain at camp until the end of the concert. The concert will be over at approximately 3:30 p.m..
- 4. Mail for Campers:** Campers love to get mail – send as much as you can! The week goes by fast, so send any mail as early in the week as possible to the address by the map.
